2 of 2 people found the following review helpful. A Canadian book, and not a strong one. By Wayne Schiess The book includes some basic and general good-writing advice, but it is not a strong text. Too many weaknesses. First, there are too many long, block quotations from judicial opinions, and too little accompanying analysis of what was good or bad--specifically--in the quoted text. Second, the subject of judicial humor doesn't justify 14 pages of treatment. Perhaps one page to amplify on this statement: "Use it rarely, if ever, and then only toward yourself." The examples in that chapter are odd--almost none are humorous, nor does it seem that they were intended to be. Third, the book uses the words "decision," "opinion," and "judgment" in less-than-careful ways, sometimes interchangeably and often confusingly. Not good in a book on judicial writing.
