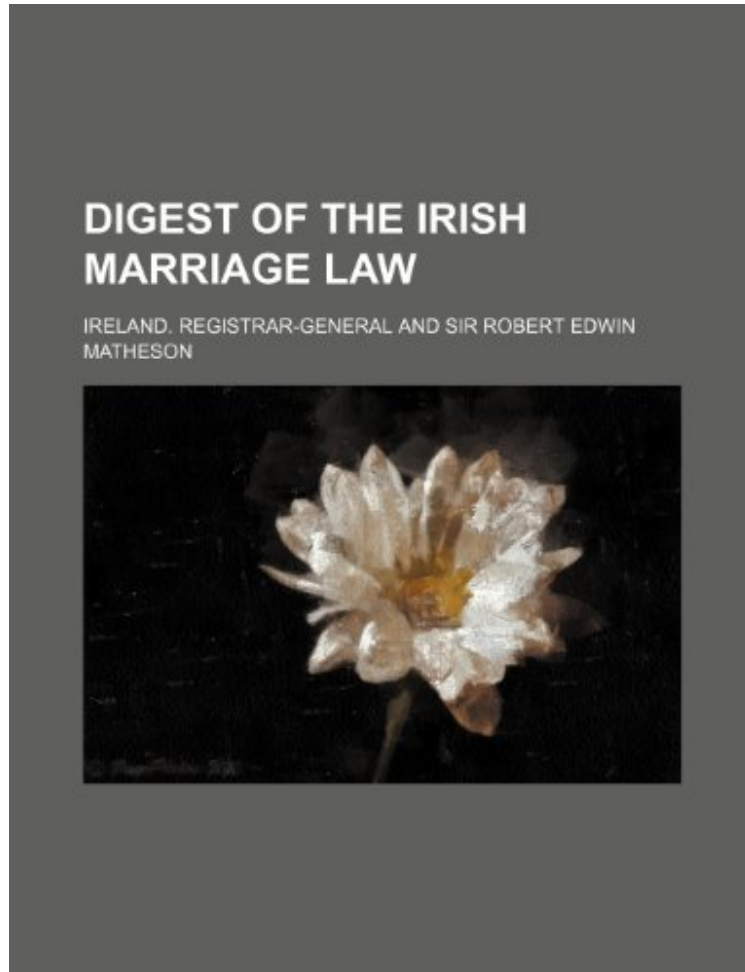

Each Presbytery is authorized to appoint, subject to 7 g v., o. the approval of the Lord Lieutenant, a sufficient number of Presbyterian ministers to issue licences for marriage in meeting-houses, duly certified, in connexion with the Presbytery. One of the parties must be a Presbyterian. A party wishing to obtain a licence must, seven days before the licence shall be delivered to him or her, produce to the licensing minister a certificate according to the form prescribed in the Act, or to the like effect from the minister of the congregation of which he or she shall be a member, and has been a member for at least one calendar...
