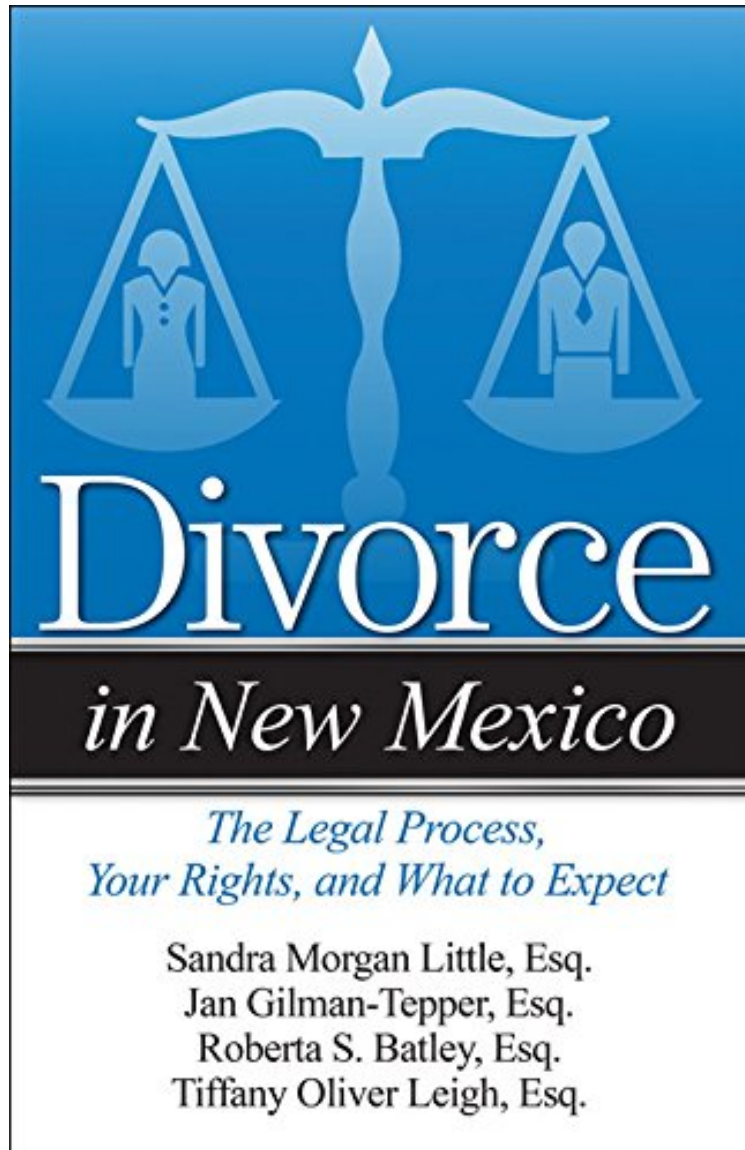

This is an interesting overview of divorce in New Mexico, but after going through a divorce, this book falls very short. In fact, it is as if this book was written to justify a lawyer's desire to bill bill bill for all the work it takes. Note that there is no section on "Separation"; the role of a psychologist isn't explained; there is no walk-through of a divorce, just possible elements of divorce. The book really doesn't help with divorce at all -- but certainly this book is intended for drive business to the law firm which authored it. Google the information -- it is more helpful and complete than this book.
