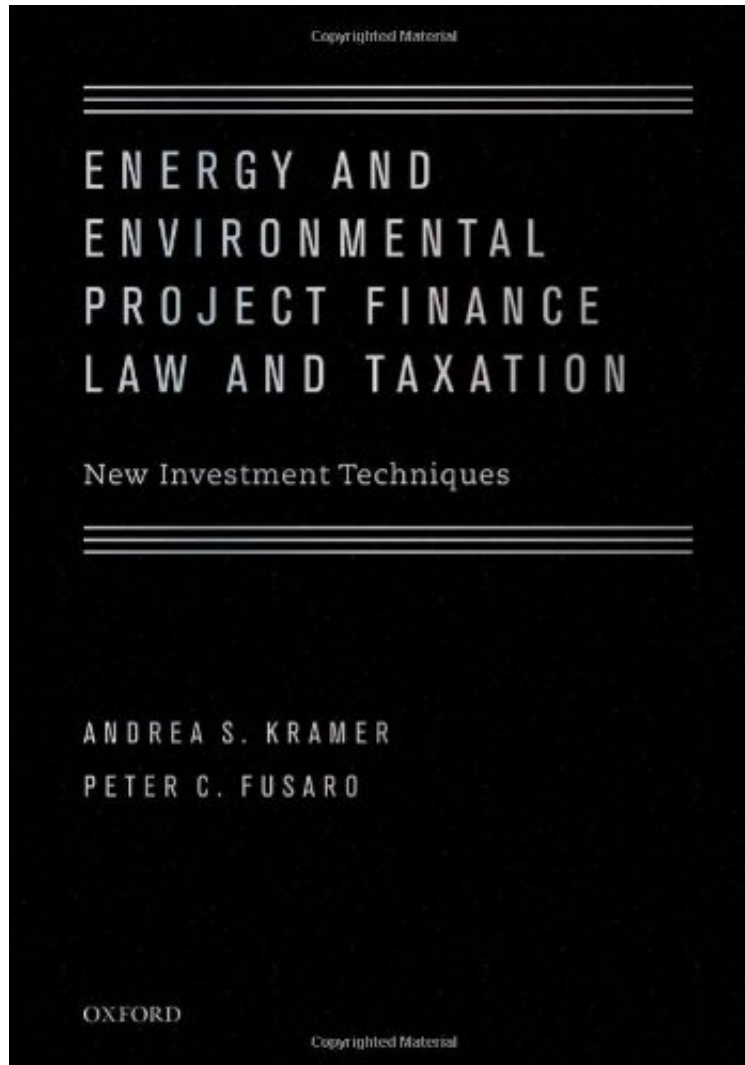

Of particular interest are the chapters devoted to U.S. tax credits and incentives for solar projects, including

those provided through the Recovery Act of 2009. Other chapters offer useful guidelines on accessing debt financing while addressing risks, a significant consideration in a restrictive credit environment. All in all, it is a very thorough study of the subject; it leaves no stone unturned. While the variety of experts featured in this tome gives way to different expository styles, the language employed is clear. Usually when you do research on project financing, the analysis is long on explanation of public information--like production tax credits or renewable portfolio standards--and short on specifics of deals. This book was helpful, in that it goes into details of contracts and investment vehicles, that aren't widely known outside of financier, developer and legal circles. Though the book can seem a bit intimidating (900+ pages), it's broken into bite-size chapters that more/less stand on their own, looking into different types of projects (carbon offset, renewable power, oil gas), and contracts. You just can't find this stuff searching around the internet. Just my two cents.
