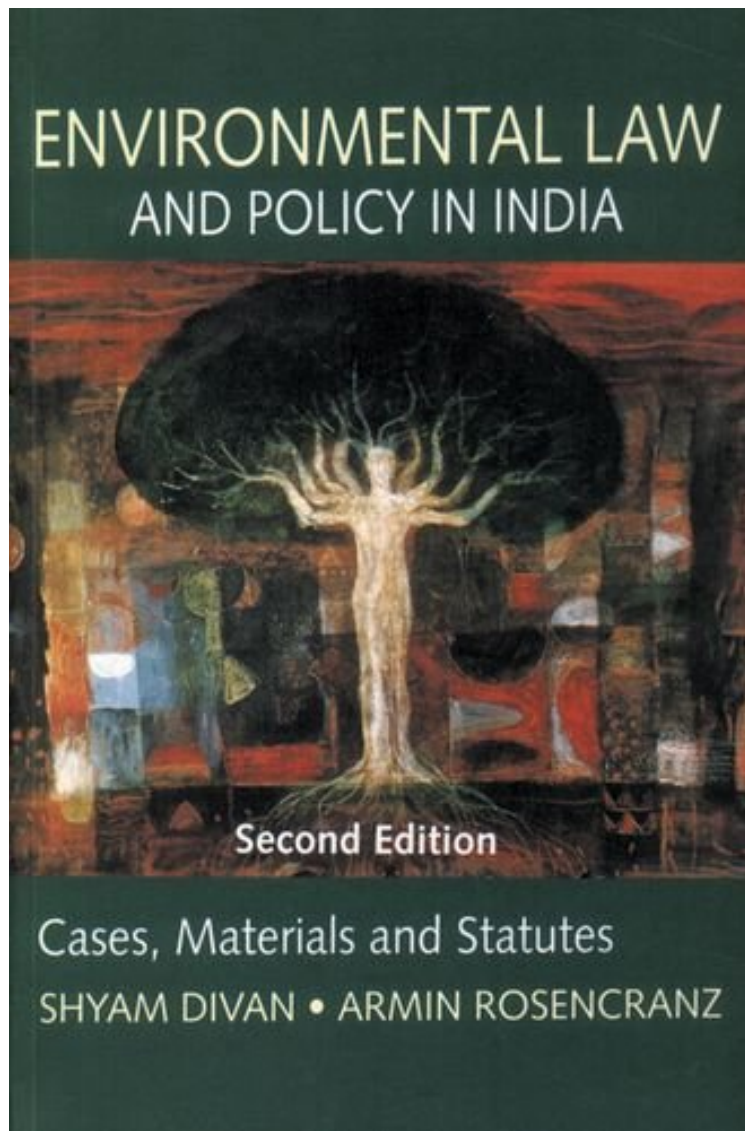

This section of society is exposed to the effects of deforestation, depletion of natural resources, and building of dams, which results in contaminated water, polluted air, poor sanitation, and scarcity of wood. This book is the second edition of the classic first edition, and now comprises clear-cut insights into landmark judgments as well as policy documents, that pertain to the environmental law and policy in the country. In total, there are 15 chapters in this book. Some chapters include International Environmental Law and Global Issues, Regulation of Hazardous Substances, Judicial Remedies and Procedures, Environmental Policy in India, and The Bhopal Gas Leak Case.
