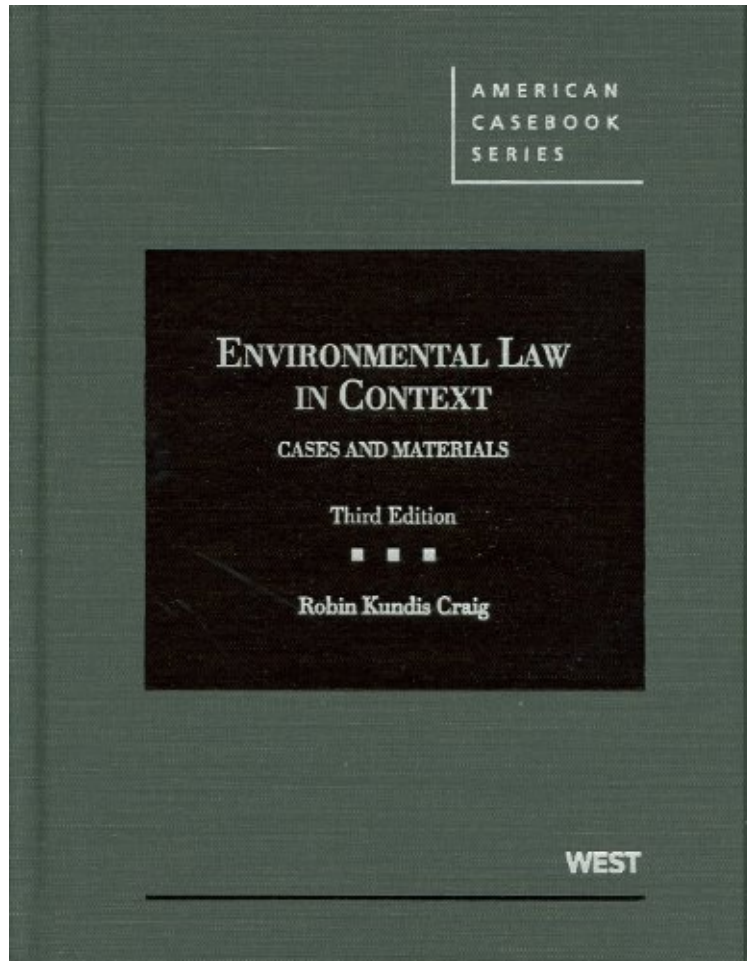

Some areas of particular interest will be recent developments in the international law of species protection and the WTO's recent dolphin safe label ruling, as well as the continuing saga of regulation (or not) of greenhouse gas emission under the Clean Air Act. The Third Edition will also emphasize the Obama Administration's new approach to environmental justice and present students with a relatively recent environmental case for the EPA's Environmental Appeals Board involving the operations of the Clean Air Act in Alaska. The Third Edition makes a concentrated effort to provide students and professors with The Rest of the Story -- the aftermath of cases and their continuing implications.
