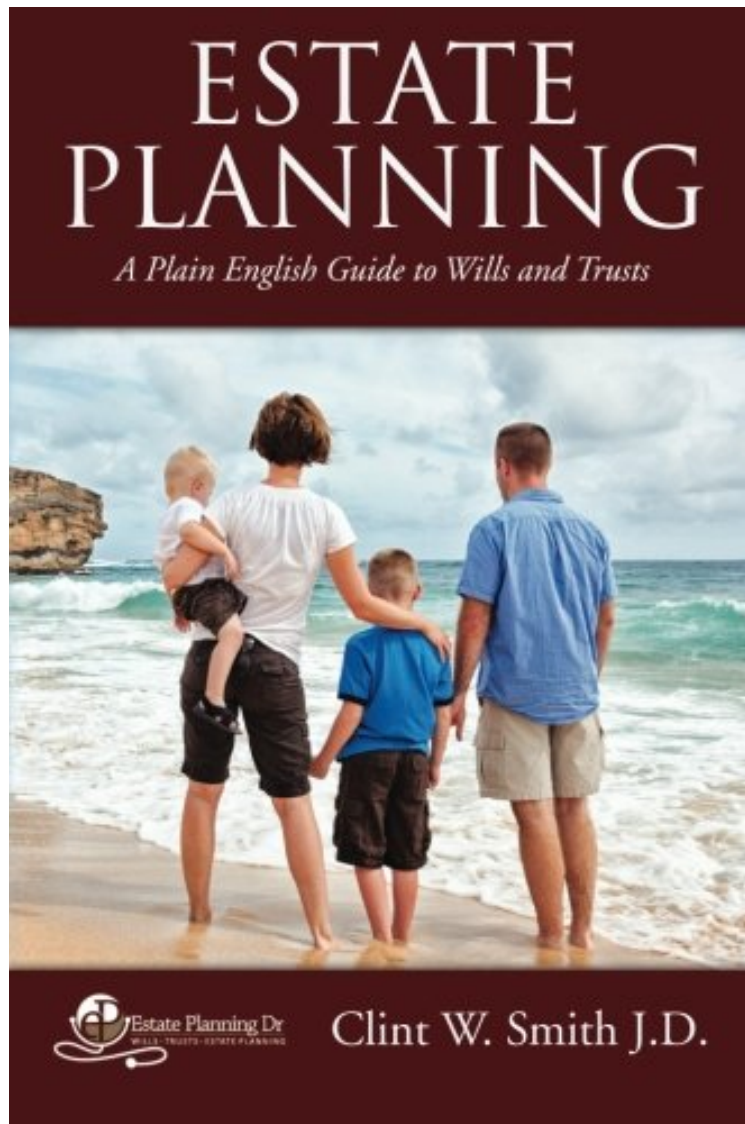

They need to be reviewed by a very experienced attorney from time to time, for compliance with the laws and this can be very expensive.
