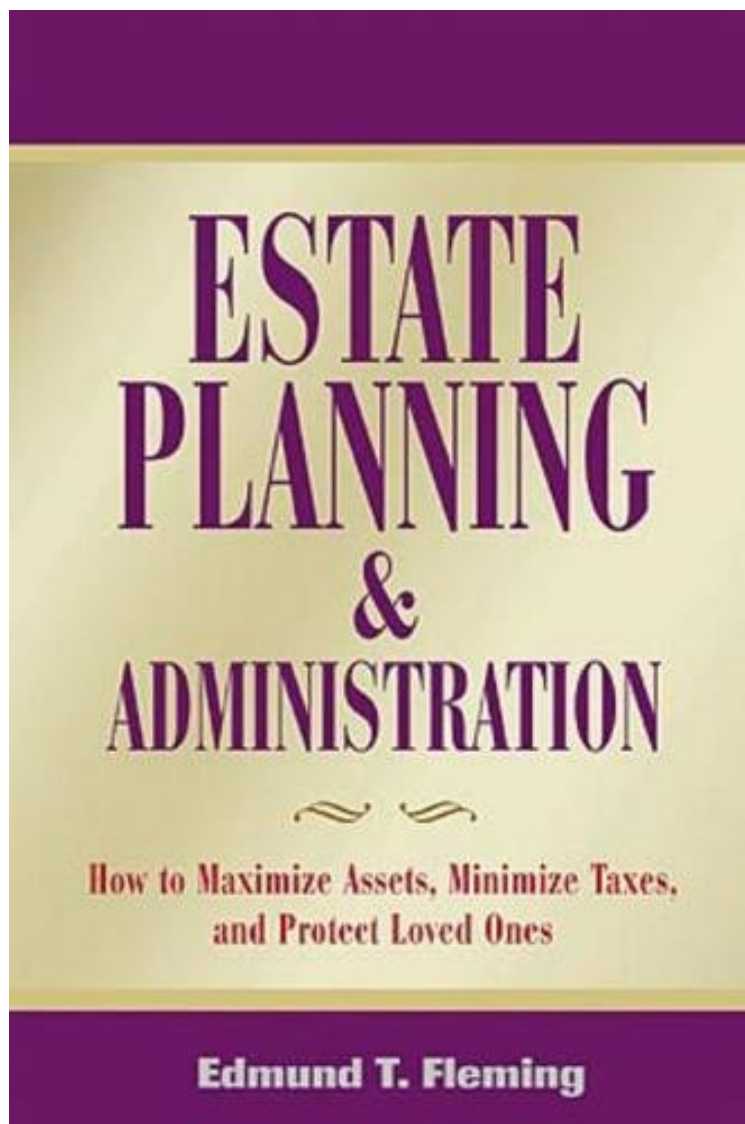

To try to understand what the attorney was proposing, it seemed reasonable to learn as much as possible, starting from a rather low knowledge base. This book was fair, but another book, in my opinion, presented the topics more clearly.
