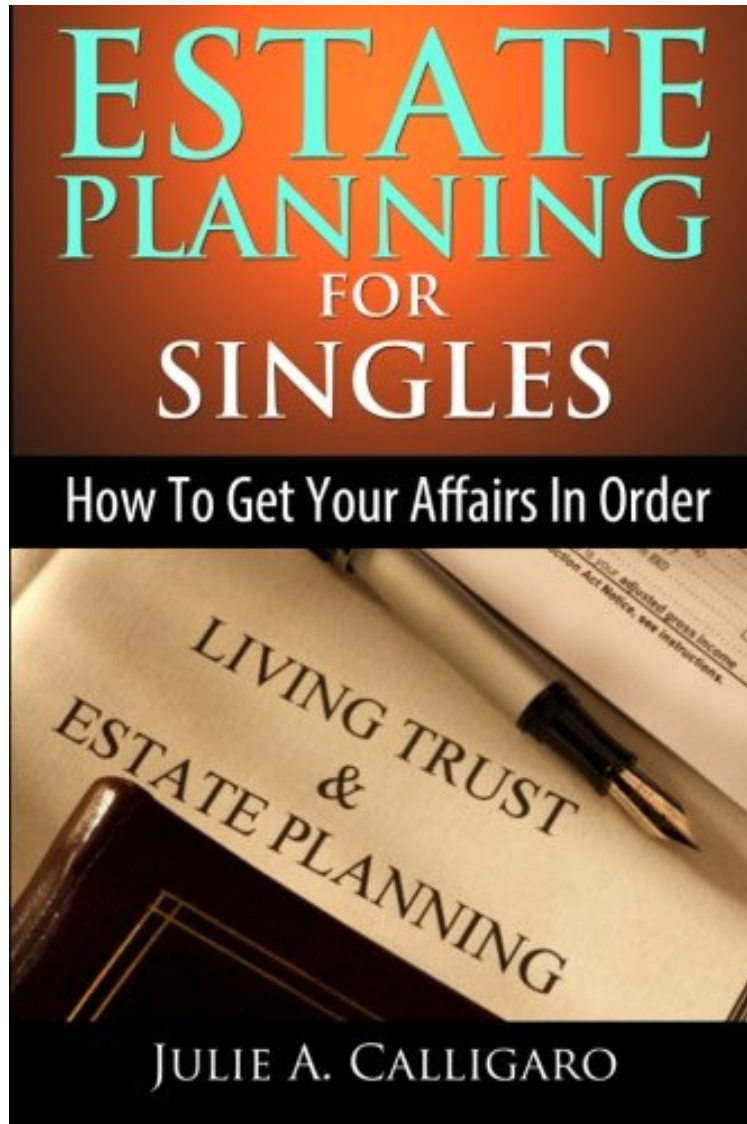

I like how the author also provides a website with the latest versions of the forms you'll need to plan your estate. Well worthwhile to spend some time getting your affairs in order and the author certainly makes it easy to do.

This book is a step-by-step estate planning guide for a single person. There are individual chapters about estate plans for singles with minor children; singles with adult children; and singles without children. If you already have an estate plan, use the book to evaluate if your estate plan is up-to-date or if changes are necessary. Some of the topics included are: wills dont avoid probate; beneficiary designations supersede wills; a power of attorney terminates when you die; always name an alternate power of attorney; estate taxes; a properly funded living trust will avoid probate; how to pick an estate planning attorney; and how a living trust differs from living wills.
