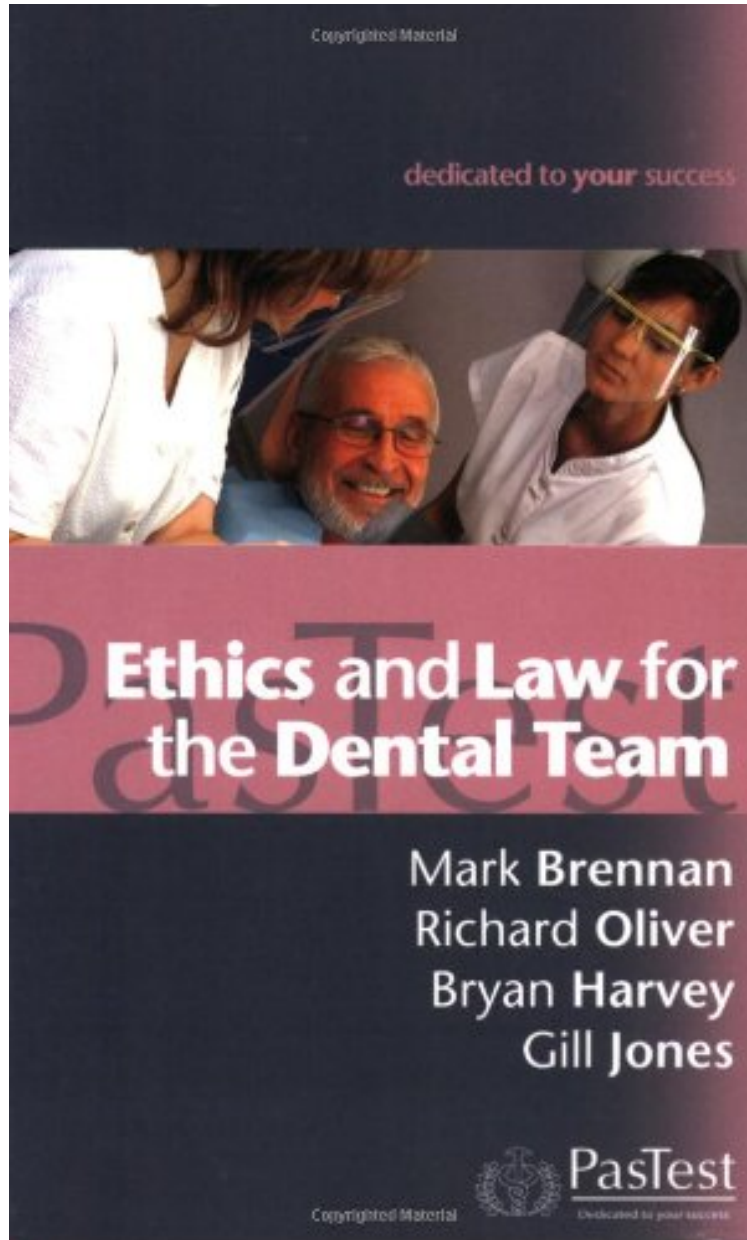

He is also Honorary Associate Dental Dean in the Postgraduate Deanery for Kent, Surrey and Sussex, and a visiting senior lecturer at Cardiff University's School of Dentistry. He qualified in medical ethics and law at King's College London (MA, 1991). He was a member of the General Dental Council working group which produced guidelines for the education and training of dental care professionals in the UK, *Developing the Dental Team* (GDC, 2003). Mark is co-author of another PasTest book, *The Practical Guide to Medical Ethics and Law* (second edition published 2005).
