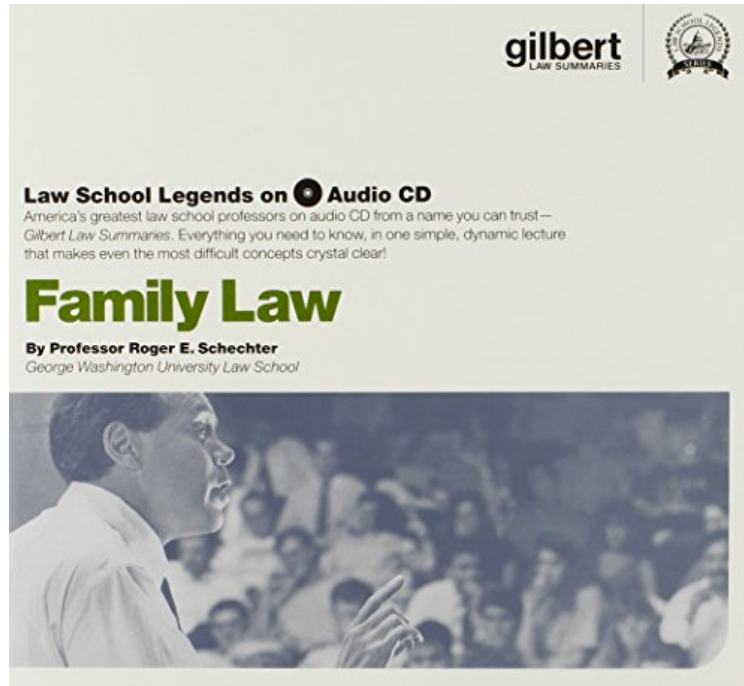

By Matthew I found the course to be very helpful. While the course of six CDs plus a 7th CD with a PDF handout, which you can print and save to your computer, covers somewhat more material than the Abridged Sum and Substance Family Law, the big difference is the handout. It is easier to understand the material while reading along with the handout. (This is specially true with the Wills and Trusts which I highly recommend.) I've found that very few CD courses cover every subject as well as a book, for example, Gilbert's Family Law covers Parenting and the audio course barely scratches the service. Also, there are many particulars to Financial Consequences of Dissolution like Interstate Enforcement that you don't really need in a broad review of Family Law. If you're looking for a preparatory course or general broad review, this will serve you well. If you want to know some of particulars of Family Law, you'll need your book, especially since it will vary from state to state.
