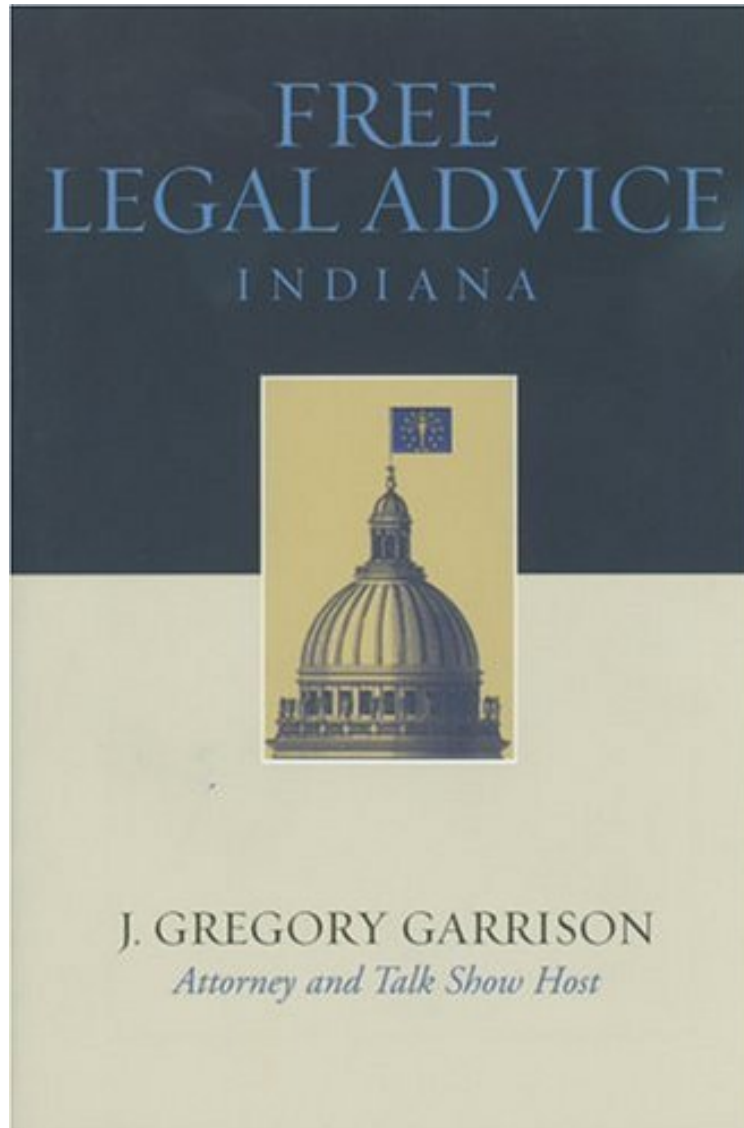

While his radio show is interesting and informative, his book lacks the same qualities.This thin paperback book is merely an outline of legal topics. Where the detailed text ought to be located which would provide the actual useful information (e.g. lists of legal rights, lists of consumer rights, small claims court limits, which legal agency to petition) you are more apt to

find only a cursory description of general vocabulary terms followed by the advice, "hire an attorney." In fact, the most often repeated legal advice presented under any heading was: Consult your attorney. Given the talent Mr. Garrison obviously has, and given his vast legal background, I hope he someday publishes a book of this nature that has sufficient content to be of practical use. Until then, there is still an enormous need for a book explaining such things as the legal rights of consumers in the state of Indiana.

From child custody and Medicaid, the range of information Greg Garrison covers is practical, timely, and free from legal jargon.
